

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, El Paso County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of El Paso County, that the El Paso County Attorney's Office – Victim Resource Program be a grant project for the period of October 1st, 2018 through September 30th, 2019 (12 month period); and

WHEREAS, El Paso County is requesting \$72,000.00 and the Commissioners Court does have to provide applicable matching funds of \$18,000.00 from the County General Funds and a \$4,000.00 in-kind match from the El Paso County Attorney's Office for the said project as required by the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division for a total project cost of \$94,000.00; and

WHEREAS, El Paso County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Criminal Justice Division funds, El Paso County assures that the funds will be returned to the Criminal Justice Division in full.

WHEREAS, El Paso County Commissioners Court designates the El Paso County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grants on behalf of El Paso County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Paso County Commissioners Court approves the grant application for the El Paso County Attorney's Office – Victim Resource Program to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
