Statement of Grant Award (SOGA)

The Statement of Grant Award is the official notice of award from the Office of the Governor (OOG). This Grant Agreement and all terms, conditions, provisions and obligations set forth herein shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the Parties and their respective successors and assigns and all other State of Texas agencies and any other agencies, departments, divisions, governmental entities, public corporations, and other entities which shall be successors to each of the Parties or which shall succeed to or become obligated to perform or become bound by any of the covenants, agreements or obligations hereunder of each of the Parties hereto.

WHEREAS, El Paso County Commissioners Court designates the El Paso County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grants on behalf of El Paso County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the El Paso County Commissioners Court approves the grant application for the El Paso County Attorney's Office – Victim Resource Program to the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division.
