The El Paso County Emergency Services District # 2 was established in 1987 and services the communities of El Paso County: Anthony, Canutillo, Clint, Fabens, Montana Vista, San Elizario, Socorro, Tornillo, Vinton and unincorporated areas within our district. We protect and serve the citizens in the El Paso County by enforcing fire codes, conducting fire investigations and providing emergency medical services.

The El Paso County Emergency Services District # 2 has six fire departments and a Fire Marshal Division:

- Clint Fire Department
- Fabens Fire Department
- Fire Marshal Division
- Montana Vista Fire Department
- San Elizario Fire Department
- Socorro Fire Department
- West Valley Fire Department

We support the six volunteer fire departments, the Fire Marshal Division, thirteen fire stations, one hundred sixty-five response/admin. vehicles and one hundred seventy-three volunteer firefighters.

The El Paso County Emergency Services District # 2 currently has twenty-eight employees. This consists of the District Administrator, two Administrative Assistants, four Field Administrative Assistants, Fire Marshal, four Deputy Fire Marshals, thirteen Firefighters, one Custodian, one Facilities Maintenance and one Mechanic.

The El Paso County Emergency Services District #2 is committed to protecting all citizens within the County. In doing so, our goal is to invest in new capital facilities, maintain the upkeep of our existing fire departments and training facilities and provide our members with reliable rescue units that will meet the needs of our constituents and growing populations.



In 2019-2020, ESD #2 has allocated funds to invest in creating a Capital Improvement Plan that will allow us to address the growing needs of the district in a strategic and cost-effect manner over the next 3 – 5 years.



Needed Improvements:

- 4. Plymovent System to protect firefighter and others from exposure to hazardous air.

 - 2. Office and Sleeping quarters for firefighters
 - 3. Tornillo station remodel and landscaping
 - 4. Plymovent Air System
- West Valley FD
 - 1. Paint job inside and out
 - 2. AC replacement (3)
 - 3. New roof
 - 4. Plymovent System

- 1. Demolish and rebuild part of station
