

A RESOLUTION OF THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF EL PASO, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMISSION OF A 2020-2021 HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS PROGRAM APPLICATION UNDER THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY AFFAIRS; AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY JUDGE TO ACT AS THE COUNTY'S AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE IN ALL MATTERS PERTAINING TO THE COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of El Paso County desire to develop a viable urban community, including decent housing and a suitable living environment and expanding economic opportunities, principally for persons of low/moderate income; and

WHEREAS, certain conditions exist, including stormwater hazards, which represent a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary and in the best interests of the County of El Paso to apply for funding under the 2020-2021 HOME Investment Partnerships Program;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF EL PASO, TEXAS:

- 1. That a HOME Investment Partnerships Program application is hereby authorized to be filed on behalf of the County with the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs.
- 2. That the County's application be placed in competition for funding under the HOME Single Family Development Program Application Fund.
- 3. The County of El Paso will commit \$90,000 for the 2020 2021 HOME Single Family Development Program as required by the Departments
- 4. That the Commissioners direct and designate the County Judge as the County's Chief Executive Officer and Authorized Representative to act in all matters in connection with this application and the County's participation in the 2020 HOME Investment Partnerships Program.
- 5. That existing County employees provide administrative support for this project.
