WHEREAS: During his entire career, Enrique Moreno was a tireless advocate for justice and fairness, which was recognized in 1999 when President Clinton nominated him to be a judge on the U.S. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit; and,

WHEREAS: For many years, Enrique continued to fight the good fight on behalf of people in the community and never stopped providing counsel and support for important initiatives in El Paso. He served on dozens of community boards and professional organizations and was often sought out for his advice from other leaders; and,

WHEREAS: Enrique was a person of deep faith, had an inherent sense of justice, fairness and professionalism and was a man of principle and impeccable character; and,
