- 2. Backcharges due to the water services leaks found on the field by EP County Water System Superintendent.
- 3. Adjustment of Final Quantities & Dates.

PURPOSE OF CHANGE ORDER: DESCRIBE WHAT BROUGHT ABOUT THE NEED FOR THE CHANGE ORDER.

- 1. At the request by the Owner, the Contractor is directed to reconnect the 6-inch existing stand pipe to the newly installed 6-inch water main across Vista del Este Dr. This change would result in a contract cost to the project of \$2,974.00. Notice of Discovering Incomplete Work for Water Yard Lines and Removal of

Existing Meters

Dear Mr. Dietrich,

As of the print date of this letter, the County continues to receive letters from Project residents complaining of abnormal high water bills due to water leaks found within their properties. The water leaks have been confirmed and are attributed to failing to install a water plug along the existing water service line; a task that was CMD's responsibility when removing the existing water meter. It was discovered, by our personnel, that the spindle of the existing meters left in place was spinning backwards.

The Measurement and Payment Section of the Contract Documents for Bid Items #8: 3/4" PVC Water Service "Yard Line" requires the installation of a plug. Furthermore, the work under Bid Item #10: Existing Water Meter Decommissioning, Removal and Salvaging, has some requirements that were not fulfilled under the Contract.

Reference is made to Section 16, Page 40 of the Contract Documents and written verbatim below, where under the "Fixed Price Construction Contract Between Owner and Contractor" the following applies:

Section 16. Discovering and Correcting Defective or Incomplete Work" the following subparagraphs would apply to this notice:

(A) In the event that the Contractor covers, conceals or obscures its work in violation of this Contract or in violation of a directive from the Owner or the Project

Manager, such work shall be uncovered and displayed for the Owner's and Project Manager's inspection upon request, and shall be reworked at no cost in time and money to the Owner;

- (B) If any of the work is covered, concealed or obscured in a manner not covered by Subparagraph 16(A) above, it shall, if directed by the Owner or the Project Manager be uncovered and displayed for the Owner's or Project Manager's inspection. If the uncovered work conforms strictly to this Contract, the costs incurred by the Contractor to uncover and subsequently, replace such work shall be borne by the Owner. Otherwise, such costs shall be borne by the Contractor;
- (C) The Contractor shall, at no cost in time or money to the Owner, correct work rejected by the Owner or by the Project Manager as defective or failing to conform to this Contract. Additionally, the Contractor shall reimburse the Owner for all testing, inspections and other expenses incurred as a result thereof;
- (D) In addition to its warranty obligations set forth elsewhere herein, the Contractor shall be specifically obligated to correct any and all defective or nonconforming work for a period of TWO (2) years following final completion upon written direction from the Owner.
- (E) The Owner may, but shall in no event be required to, choose to accept defective or nonconforming work. In such event, The Contract Price shall be reduced by the greater of (1) the reasonable costs of removing and correcting the defective or nonconforming work, and (2) the difference between fair market value of the Project as constructed and the fair market value of the Project had it not been constructed in such a manner as to include defective or nonconforming work. If the remaining portion of the unpaid Contract Price, if any, is insufficient to compensate the Owner for the acceptance of defective or nonconforming work, the Contractor shall, upon written demand from the Owner, pay the Owner such remaining compensation for accepting defective or nonconforming work.

Based on the language of the Contract above, the County will issue a change order to deduct a total of \$8,203.34 from your Contract to cover the cost to reimburse the residents what is rightfully owed to them. CMD has every right to challenge this dispute/claim, but the facts point to deficient work under the Contract. Refer to attached breakdown to justify the amount being claimed.
