ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT AMENDMENT # 1

AGREEMENT

1. Description of Amended Items

a. The date of the resolution was omitted on the first page of the contract. The fifth paragraph of the contract is now deleted and replaced with the following:

The Governing Body of the Local Government approved entering into the agreement by Resolution, ordinance, or commissioners court order dated **January 27, 2020** which is attached to and made a part of this Agreement as Attachment A, Resolution, Ordinance, or Commissioners Court Order (Attachment A).

b. The term of the contract is changed from 15 months to three years in order to utilize all funds allocated for this project.

Article 1: **Period of the Agreement** is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

1. Period of the Agreement

This agreement becomes effective when signed by the last party whose signing makes the agreement fully executed. This agreement shall remain in effect until the close of the ordinary business on January 31, 2023.

c. The term "budge" of the contract in Attachment B, 1st paragraph is deleted and replace with budget.

All other provisions of the original contract are unchanged and remain in full force and effect.
