

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, El Paso County Commissioners Court finds it in the best interest of the citizens of El Paso County, that the El Paso County Sheriff's Office, Constable Precinct One and Constable Precinct Six – Operation Stonegarden Grant Program, FY20, for the Office of the Governor – Homeland Security Grant Program be operated for the period of March 01, 2021 through February 28, 2022; and

WHEREAS, El Paso County Commissioners Court does not have to provide applicable matching funds for the said project as required by the Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Division; and

WHEREAS, El Paso County Commissioners Court agrees that in the event of loss or misuse of the Homeland Security Grant Program funds, El Paso County assures that the funds will be returned to the Homeland Security Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, El Paso County Commissioners Court designates the El Paso County Judge as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official is given the power to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grants on behalf of El Paso County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of El Paso Commissioners Court approves the grant application for the El Paso County Sheriff's Office (EPCSO), Constable Precinct One and Constable Precinct Six Grant Program for the Office of the Governor, Homeland Security Grant Program.
