General Information

1. Describe the proposed project(s) for which the funds will be used. *

Commuter bus service will be provided 6 days a week from the Towns of Anthony and Clint, the Village of Vinton, the Cities of Socorro and Horizon and the unincorporated areas of Westway, Canutillo, Montana Vista, Agua Dulce, Sparks, Fabens and Tornillo to the City of El Paso. Service is configured on several routes provided using Type III, wheelchair lift-equipped cutaway buses with each route stopping at a Sun Metro Transfer Center. County Served El Paso County. Hours of Operation - 5:40 AM to 8:10 PM, Monday to Saturday. El Paso County Transit plans to expand service beginning FY2023, therefore possible additional routes (identified in Task Order 10 by TTI), as well as additional service hours/days, will be added to current services and these funds will also be used for administration of those changes. (TTI's Task Order 10 "Best Practices and Guidelines for EPC Rural Public Transportation to Identify Potential Stop Locations and Route Configurations" is available upon request, unable to upload more than one attachment). 2. Provide a description of how the need/demand for the proposed project(s) was determined. *

The proposed service represents a continuation of historical services provided by the El Paso County Transit since 1995. Pre-COVID-19, ridership on all routes continued to increase. In response, service increased in FY 2020-2021 with continuous daytime service still available on all routes. Service was first designed to provide access to the City of El Paso for residents of communities in rural El Paso County. Each route has a scheduled stop at a Sun Metro Transfer Center providing connection to Sun Metro routes, connection to the El Paso/Anthony/Las Cruces intercity bus service and convenient access to downtown El Paso and most locations throughout the region. State Rural funds are crucial to sustain the current service because people need more rides to connect to the inner City of El Paso. El Paso County Transit plans to expand service beginning FY 2023, therefore possible additional routes (identified in Task Order 10 by TTI), as well as additional service hours/days, will be added to current services, which continues El Paso County's efforts to increase service options and close transportation gaps. (TTI's Task Order 10 "Best Practices and Guidelines for EPC Rural Public Transportation to Identify Potential Stop Locations and Route Configurations" is available upon request, unable to upload more than one attachment). County served is El Paso County, including the towns of Anthony and Clint, the Village of Vinton, the cities of Socorro and Horizon and the unincorporated areas of Westway, Canutillo, Montana Vista, Agua Dulce, Sparks, Fabens and Tornillo. Ridership audience includes all residents of El Paso County. Hours of Operation - 5:40 AM to 8:10 PM, Monday to Saturday. Funds for the El Paso County Transit Commuter Bus Service will be applied as follows: \$466,139 for administration purposes only.

3. Describe the anticipated benefits of the project. *

Increased service frequency reduces passenger wait times and time to final destination resulting in improved access to regional destinations and amenities. Minimal fleet redundancy assures service reliability. Individuals are generally happy with service if not satisfied with service. The El Paso County Transit provides connectivity from rural El Paso County to the inner city of El Paso and vice versa. Customer service is addressed immediately and directly. Increased service and hours are improvements being made to the program. County Served El Paso County. Hours of Operation - 5:40 AM to 8:10 PM, Monday to Saturday. Funds for the El Paso County Transit Commuter Bus Service will be applied as follows: \$466,139 for administration purposes only.

Congestion Mitigation & Air Quality Improvement Program in El Paso County

The CMAQ program was implemented to support surface transportation projects and other related efforts that contribute air quality improvements and provide congestion relief.

The CMAQ program provides a flexible funding source to State and local governments for transportation projects and programs to help meet the requirements of the Clean Air Act. Funding is available to reduce congestion and improve air quality for areas that do not meet the National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS) for ozone, carbon monoxide, or particulate matter-nonattainment areas and for areas that were out of compliance but have now met the standards-maintenance areas.

The Mission Trail Express serves the Lower Valley by providing both visitors to and residents of the community a connection between three municipalities—El Paso, Socorro and San Elizario. The route also increases access to some of the County's historical assets. By promoting use of transit, residents can help reduce traffic congestion and improve the air quality of this beautiful and historic corridor.

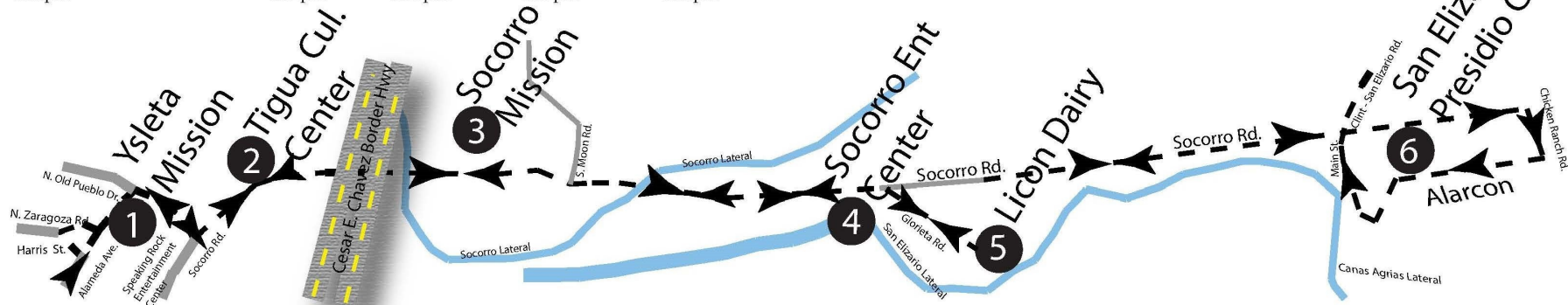
