WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court plays a vital role in supporting the fight against pediatric cancer at El Paso Children's Hospital; and,

WHEREAS, in 2012 the Obama Administration proclaimed September as National Childhood Cancer Awareness Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the El Paso County Judge and Commissioners Court do hereby declare September 12 be known as:

"El Paso Children's Hospital Childhood Cancer Awareness Day"
