RESOLUTION



WHEREAS, local businesses provide opportunities for entrepreneurs, jobs for neighbors, and gathering places for communities. For the past three years Old Sheepdog Brewery has gone above and beyond to celebrate El Paso; and

WHEREAS, Old Sheepdog Brewery is located at 3900 Rosa Ave. in an industrial warehouse built in the 1930s in South Central, the heart of El Paso; and

WHEREAS, not even a global pandemic could stop them as Old Sheepdog Brewery opened its doors in December 2019 and three months later had to close due to the pandemic; however, the brewery hosted drive-by events and participated in Save El Paso Breweries events; and

WHEREAS, the co-owners Brisa and Gus Delgado have demonstrated their love for El Paso in many ways, including highlighting some of its original neighborhoods south of the freeway with their first Barrio Love Series, which included beers that celebrated Segundo Barrio, South Central, and the Lower Valley; and

WHEREAS, Old Sheepdog Brewery has also supported many community initiatives and causes critical to El Paso, such as the Diocesan Migrant and Refugee Services “You Belong” community event to welcome migrants, fundraising for breast cancer awareness in collaboration with local car clubs and Lincoln Park Conservation Committee, and by opening up their space to local artists and vendors; and

WHEREAS, this year, Old Sheepdog Brewery sponsored the El Paso County kickoff event for “Corazón, Historia, Raíces” by hosting the history showcase series of speakers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the El Paso County Judge and Commissioners Court that El Paso County recognizes Gus and Brisa Delgado, co-owners of Old Sheepdog Brewery, for their resilience, creativity, and dedication to the El Paso Community. They truly brew “**la Cerveza del Pueblo.**”
