Most of the buildings in Duranguito's Chihuahua and Overland streets date back to the early 19th century. Each one of these buildings tell a rich and fascinating story of the hirth of modern day El Paso, where immigrants from all over the world made their homes. The area houses several of the city's most historic buildings, including the last surviving edifice of the El Paso's early Chinese community, Victorian-era homes constructed in the late 19th century by prominent frenterizo families, and a 1930 firehouse designed by famed architect Henry Trest.







"Develop programs to focus on infill and rehabilitation of existing neighborhoods."





ACTION REQUEST

- Explore the possibility the County of El Paso's direct involvement in the restoration of the Duranguito community.
- Explore a joint City-County partnership to formulate a plan for the restoration of Duranguito.
- Explore the possibility of the County purchasing Duranguito historic buildings that would be sold or leased to non-profit organizations that would follow the plan's guidelines.
- Set up meetings with Paso del Sur, Project Regeneracion and other non-profit organizations to begin developing a communitygenerated plan for the restoration of Duranguito.
