

**SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT
PROJECT DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT FOR THE
JOHN HAYES STREET EXTENSION PROJECT**

THIS SIXTH AMENDMENT TO THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT (the “Amendment”) is made and entered into effective as of the ____ day of _____, 2023, by and between EL PASO COUNTY, TEXAS (the “County”) and the CAMINO REAL REGIONAL MOBILITY AUTHORITY (“CRRMA”), (each a “Party” and collectively, the “Parties”), for the purposes described herein.

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the County and CRRMA entered into an Interlocal Agreement – Project Development Agreement for the John Hayes Street Extension Project dated November 4, 2019 as revised via the First Amendment dated October 5, 2020, Second Amendment dated October 4, 2021, the Third Amendment dated August 1, 2022, the Fourth Amendment dated January 23, 2023, and the Fifth Amendment dated October 10, 2023 (collectively, the “Interlocal Agreement”), which provided funds necessary for the development of the extension of the John Hayes Street including purchase of certain rights of way (the “Project”); and

WHEREAS, the referenced Fifth Amendment provided that certain funds were being provided by the County to the CRRMA for use in the construction of the Project but the Fifth Amendment did not identify when those funds would be made available to the CRRMA; and

WHEREAS, the Parties now desire to further amend the Interlocal Agreement in order to clarify when the construction funding provided pursuant to the Fifth Amendment is to be made available from the County to the CRRMA.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants and agreements herein contained, the undersigned Parties agree as follows:

1. Payments from the County. The County shall transfer the Project funds identified as Construction funds in **EXHIBIT C-5** of the Interlocal Agreement to the CRRMA within ten (10) days of the date first noted above.

2. Ratification. Except as expressly amended by this Amendment, the Interlocal Agreement and its exhibits shall remain in full force and effect.

3. Execution in Counterparts. This Amendment may be simultaneously executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be an original and all of which shall be considered fully executed as of the date first written above, when both Parties have executed an identical counterpart, notwithstanding that all signatures may not appear on the same counterpart.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Parties have executed and attested this Amendment by their officers thereunto duly authorized.
