RESOLUTION



WHEREAS, Mike Maddux was born Aug. 27, 1961 in Dayton, Ohio, the son of Dave and Linda Maddux and the brother of Greg Maddux. It's quite possible they were born with baseballs in their hands, as both went on to outstanding pitching careers in Major League Baseball (MLB); and

WHEREAS, Mike Maddux was initially selected by the Cincinnati Reds during the 36th round of the 1979 MLB draft, but decided instead to attend the University of Texas at El Paso (UTEP), where he was the star pitcher on the 1985 UTEP NCAA baseball team; and

WHEREAS, After college, he continued his career in baseball, playing for nine MLB teams over 15 years, starting with four years on the Philadelphia Phillies and pitching his last season on the Houston Astros in 2000. Maddux then went on to an MLB coaching career; and

WHEREAS, Mike Maddux coached for four MLB teams - Milwaukee Brewers (2003–2008), Texas Rangers (2009-2015), Washington Nationals (2016-2017), St. Louis Cardinals (2018-2022) - and returned to the Texas Rangers as pitching coach in 2023; and

WHEREAS, Mike Maddux presided over the Rangers longest stretch of organizational success from 2009-2015. The Rangers posted four consecutive seasons of sub-4.00 team Earned Run Average's (ERAs) from '10-13 during this time. Returning to keep this legacy of success, Maddux coached the Rangers to DOMINATE the 2023 MLB World Series with a 4-1 finish;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the El Paso County Judge and Commissioners Court commends Mike Maddux and joins the University of Texas El Paso and many others in honoring him on the 20th of January, 2024, for his work in helping the Texas Rangers win a World Series and Making El Paso Proud!
